Sno-Isle TECH Skill Center, located near Paine Field in Everett, is a cooperative effort of 14 local school districts serving **high school juniors and seniors**. Students generally attend Sno-Isle for half of the school day and take regular classes at their home high school the other half. The purpose of skills centers like Sno-Isle Tech is to provide preparatory training, certification, and post-secondary credit to students, who can then choose to continue their education, go straight to work, or both.
